The department "Farms, resource protection and regional development" of the Institute for Socio-economics at ZALF developed a bio-economic model at farm level that simulates economic and ecological impacts of agricultural and environmental policies ([www.modam.eu](http://www.modam.eu)). MODAM (Multi-Objective Decision support tool for Agro-ecosystem Management) model simulates agricultural decision-making behaviour with the help of a programming approach and assesses the environmental effects of land use.
