

International MONICA User Class at ZALF

In the week after Easter, ZALF offered an international block class for MONICA users. In the mornings, Prof. Nendel provided the theoretical background of the processes used in the simulation model, and Michael Berg-Mohnicke then demonstrated the technical tricks of using the model in different situations. The international participants then each had the opportunity in the afternoon to set up and advance their own simulation projects and to get individual support from the ZALF staff in the virtual space.
